On March 13, the <u>California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC)</u> announced its first draft list of proposed priority products to be subject to the new California Safer Consumer Products (SCP) regulations. The regulations will affect businesses that manufacture, import, distribute, sell, or assemble the regulated consumer products.
